

Nose Mask Installation Tips

- The nose masks are designed to fit quite tightly to keep them from moving once installed. This can make them appear to be too small the first time they are installed; especially in cooler weather.
- In weather below 70 degrees the material won't have enough give to allow it to stretch when installing; especially the first time it is installed.
- If possible set the mask in the sun to allow it to warm before installing, even when it is warmer than 70 degrees.
- If it is cold outside warm the material inside first. If needed a hairdryer can be used to warm the mask during install. Be careful not to overheat the vinyl material though
- A second person can be very helpful with the first install as the material won't have been stretched to the car yet.
 - The hood section can be very snug and a second person can help to pull and slowly stretch it to fit completely.
 - On areas where tabs have to slide between the parts of the car a second person can help lightly pull those sections apart to allow the tab to slide in.
- Do not machine wash or machine dry the mask
- If it gets wet, remove it from the vehicle to allow it to dry or it may damage the paint.
